Event Outline

1. Eco based Project Display:

There will be three categories for the participants:

Group A: Class 3 – 5, Group B: Class 6 – 8, Group C: Class 9 -12

The participants will submit projects that will be judged by a panel on the last day of the display. The projects must be environmental and ecological conservation-themed.

2. Wall Magazine:

Students can participate as single parties or groups of 2-4. They can be from different institution. The wall magazine must have themes of nature, the environment and ecological conservation.

3. Photography Carnival:

Participants can submit any number of photographs following the submission process that will be posted in detail in a separate post. The selected photos will be displayed at the photography display during the fest. The winner will have their photo featured in our yearly publication.

4. Pinpoint on map:

Participants will have to answer questions with the help of a given map in teams of 2. The members can be of different institution. Further details will be published in a separate post. Top three teams from each category will be awarded.

5. Olympiads:

There will be three categories for the participants:

Group A: Class 6 - 8, Group B: Class 9 - 10, Group C: Class 11 - 12

These are single events. Participants will get X minutes to answer questions on various topics of Biology. The top three participants from each group will be awarded.

 - 6. Turn the coat:

Single event. Each participant must first select a topic (they will all be nature and environment-themed). They will get 3 minutes to prepare and 3 minutes to speak. Each participant must speak for 1.5 minutes in favour of the topic and 1.5 minutes against it. The top three from each category will be awarded.

7. Anagram:

Single event. This event is only for participants of class 3-4 and 5-6. Students must rearrange given anagrams to find the required words. Top three will be awarded from each category.

8. General Knowledge Quiz:
